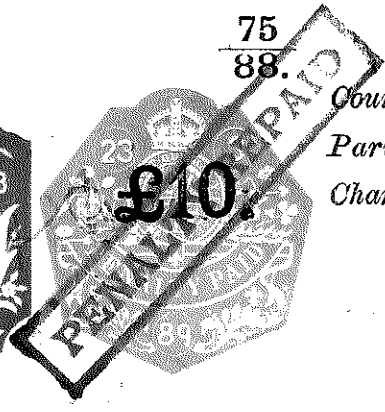

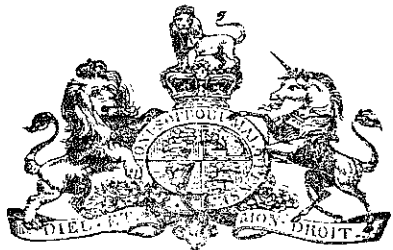

CHARITY COMMISSION.

In the Matter of the NATIONAL SCHOOL, at CROXLEY GREEN, comprised in an Indenture dated 30th June 1873, and made between Alfred Peddle of the one part, and the Reverend Alleyne Higgs Barker and three others of the other part, in the Parish of RICKMANSWORTH, in the County of HERTFORD; and

In the Matter of "The Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1887."

Whereas an application in writing for the purposes of the following Order was made to The Board of Charity Commissioners for England and Wales, on the 27th day of September 1887, in the matter of the above-mentioned Charity, by

The Reverend ALFRED EDWARD NORTHEY, Vicar of the above-mentioned Parish of Rickmansworth; and

RODERICK WILLIAM HENDERSON,
 JOHN WHITE, and
 HARVEY WINSON FELLOWS, the Church-
 wardens of the same Parish ;
 who were then the Trustees of the said Charity :

And whereas the endowment of the said Charity consists of the School buildings, with their site and appurtenances, which are occupied and used for the purposes of the said Charity, and are not productive of income for its benefit :

And whereas the said School buildings belonging to the said Charity are situate at Croxley Green, which is now a separate Ecclesiastical Parish :

And whereas it is desirable that

The VICAR and CHURCHWARDENS of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Croxley Green,
 should be substituted for

The VICAR and CHURCHWARDENS of the said Parish of Rickmansworth,
 as the Trustees of the said Charity :

And whereas notice of the intention of the said Board to make an Order for the foregoing objects has been published by the affixing of the same, according to the direction of the said Board, to or near a principal outer door of the Parish Churches of Rickmansworth and Croxley Green on the 31st day of October and the 1st day of November 1887, and by advertisement in the "Watford Observer" newspaper on the 5th and 12th days of November 1887, being in each case more than one calendar month previously to the date hereof :

And whereas no notice of any objection to the said proposed Order has been received by the said Board :

Now the said Board do hereby Order and Direct, by way of Scheme, for the future administration of the said Charity, That

The VICAR and CHURCHWARDENS of the said Parish of Croxley Green for the time being, in

right and during tenure of their said respective offices and their respective successors, shall be substituted as Trustees of the said School for the
VICAR and CHURCHWARDENS of Rickmansworth aforesaid :

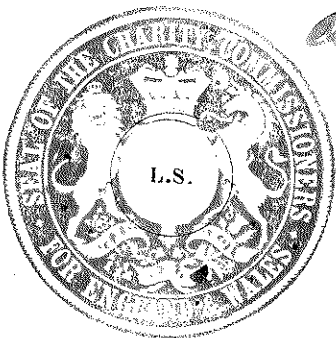
And that

The **VICAR and CHURCHWARDENS** of Rickmansworth aforesaid, and their respective successors ;

be and they are hereby removed and discharged from acting in the management and administration of the said Charity :

And the said Board do hereby further Order and Direct, That in all other respects the provisions contained in the above-mentioned Deed of the 30th June 1873 for the regulation and management of the said Charity, shall be confirmed and established so far as the same shall not be at variance, or inconsistent with the directions aforesaid.
